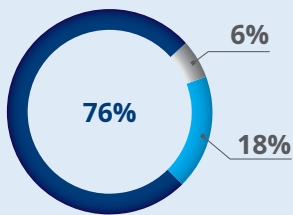


NSPA is the lead organisation for multinational acquisition, support and sustainment to NATO nations.

Since its establishment in 1958, NSPA acquires, operates, and maintains everything through an unbiased link between industry and the nations, enabling the consolidation and centralisation of logistics management functions, providing a “cradle to grave” support and allowing its customers to achieve economies of scale.

NSPA is a customer-funded agency, operating on a “no profit - no loss” basis. The Agency is headquartered in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, with main operational centres in France, Hungary, Italy and the United States.

LIFE CYCLE MANAGEMENT

NSPA provides a broad spectrum of responsive, effective and cost-efficient “cradle to grave” management of defence equipment, products and services to NATO, NATO member and partner nations, individually and collectively.

The integrated capability spectrum includes:

Systems Acquisition and Armaments Procurement, Life management, including full logistics fleet support, Integrated Logistics Support and Services, Supply Chain Management and Automation, Strategic Transport and Storage, Project Management in all Land, Air, Naval and Joint Services capability domains.



SUPPORT TO OPERATIONS, MISSIONS & EXERCISES

For over 60 years, NSPA has provided considerable expertise in the provision of support services in different operational theatres, contributing to the readiness of the Alliance's forces and the strengthening of NATO's Defence and Deterrence posture. The Agency currently provides an extensive support to NATO operations in Kosovo, national operations in Iraq, Tunisia, and NATO exercises across the world.

Support to Operations & Exercises: Procurement, transport, stockpiling & maintenance, Medical, Fuel provision, Engineering & construction, Mobile infrastructure.

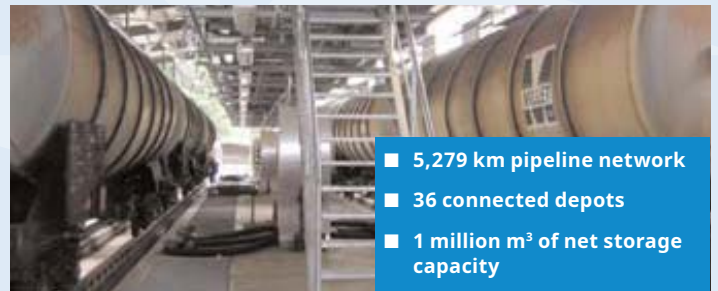
Implementation of NATO Trust Funds: Capacity building & training, De-militarisation & de-mining, Ammo disposal & hazardous waste, Medical.

CENTRAL EUROPE PIPELINE SYSTEM (CEPS) PROGRAMME

NSPA manages the largest pipeline system in NATO. The CEPS provides storage and transportation of fuel across Central Europe, delivering fuel to military airbases and civilian airports.

Through CEPS, NSPA supports NATO's Deterrence & Defence posture, contributing to the readiness of the Alliance.



NATO AIRLIFT MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME (NAMP)



Through NAMP, NSPA manages the full life cycle management (including acquisition and sustainment) of the three Globemaster C-17 aircraft stationed at Pápa Airbase, including acquisition and sustainment on behalf of the member Nations of the Strategic Airlift Capability (SAC).

The SAC provides assured access to strategic military airlift capability for its 12 member nations:



SUPPORT PARTNERSHIPS

NSPA brings nations together by providing multinational cooperation solutions and mechanisms that allow nations to combine their efforts, consolidate and share resources and take advantage of economies of scale and interoperability. The Support Partnership (SP) structure is a unique feature of NSPA's services that provides a proven legal framework that allows two or more nations to organise common logistics support for a given weapon system.
